Woodley Leadership Academy has been working with leadership at ACCEL Schools to develop plans for each step along the way. ACCEL presented three models, with a guided decision making process to ensure the best fit for the school and community. The leadership at Woodley Leadership Academy has chosen a model that will equitably serve all of our students while providing the best resources that we are able. We are now ready to move into the next phase of implementing our program.

We have already been providing paper packets to all of our students. Prior to Spring Break, we polled our families to assess the technology resources and needs within our community. From that survey we will provide a remote learning plan that will meet the needs of our Titan Families.

For the remainder of the school year, Woodley Leadership Academy will provide a blended model of online and physical resources-Backpack Success Toolkit to keep our students learning. Online resources will be housed on our website, under the Covid-19 Resource Links.

Woodley Leadership Academy will offer students and families printed materials that can be mailed to their residence or pick-up at the school, with additional online resources and virtual instruction from iReady & Learning A-Z. Teachers will engage with students and families through phone, video conference, email, and/or text messages to offer support and ensure understanding. Intervention Specialists, related service providers, and Title I Support Teachers will continue to provide resources and support to meet the unique learning needs of all of our students.

During this challenging time, it is more clear than ever, that schools, families, and communities are partners with students in their education. Woodley Leadership Academy will continue to provide opportunities for learning and support in efforts to equitably meet the needs of all of our students while providing the best learning experiences possible.

We look forward to conquering these challenges together and ensuring that all of our students have the opportunity for continued learning during this closure period.
